Statutory Assessments

At the end of KS1 (Y2) and KS2 (Y6) pupils take part in statutory assessments (SATs). In KS1 these tests are completed in a very informal manner throughout the month of May. In KS2 the tests are much more prescriptive and will take place during the week commencing 14th May. The timetable will be as follows:



- Monday 14th May: Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation
- Tuesday 15th May: Reading
- Wednesday 17th May: Maths Paper 1 (Arithmetic) and Maths Paper 2 (Reasoning)
- Thursday 18th May: Maths Paper 3 (Reasoning)
- Friday 19th May: No tests

Both Y2 and Y6 staff have held information evenings to explain testing arrangements to parents and KS2 study guides are available to buy from the school office, priced at £6 each. If you are at all concerned about SATs or you feel you require more information, please contact your child's class teacher.

In addition, as in previous years, children in Y1 are required to take a phonics screening check. This again will take place in a very informal way during the week commencing Monday 11th June. Although she will have just begun covering maternity leave in EYFS, Miss Fancey will be available to administer the test and support her Y1 pupils during this week.

Storytime in the Space

St Mary's Church have asked that we let families know that "Storytime in the Space" will be starting again this week. The club, telling Bible stories with a twist, takes place weekly on Tuesdays—straight after school at St Mary's Church and is open to all families of all faiths.
