**Homework: On-going**

**Reading:**

- Target for all - We would love the children to read at least 3 times a week at home.
- This could be the hard copy reading book received from school, a book from the library or a book from home.

**Spelling:**

- Phonics and Common exception 'Tricky words'. Spellings will be given out on a Friday with 2 graphemes (sounds) and words to practise for a spelling test the following Friday.

**Maths:**

- Green maths cards will be given out - these are on-going and will develop with your child. This is the chance to gain a bronze, silver or gold sticker for attainment in learning important key skills and quick recall number facts/ counting. These are to keep in book bags to practise at home and an adult in school will assess and move your child onto the next level.

**Topic/ Writing**

- We may occasionally give writing homework or activities to support our current topic.

If we feel it is important to give homework for other subjects, then we will not give Spelling homework for that week as we understand that time at home is precious.
