Deep in the Rainforest




Music:

We ask that the children access these apps little but often completing their daily doodle questions plus new learning at least 4 times a week.

Phonics

- As your child missed their year 1 phonics screening check in the last academic year, we will be catching up with this in the second half of the Autumn term. We may, therefore, set some extra phonics homework via the seesaw class app during the autumn term, or your child may be given some phonics sounds to work on at home.

Art

- Mrs Jones (Art Co-ordinator) has asked us to set a half termly art-based homework task this year. This will be something fun that the children can complete at home across the term linked to our topic. We will be collecting in the project pieces at the end of the half term, and we will have a gallery afternoon, where the children can exhibit and share their pieces. Hopefully, at the end of the school day we will also be able to invite parents in to have a wonder around our gallery.
