

This half term, the children will be:

- Considering changes in levels when dancing

Doodle:

- Across school, children will be completing their homework via the online doodle apps. There are 4 apps – doodle maths, tables, English and spelling. We ask that the children access these apps little but often – completing their doodle questions plus new learning at least 4 times a week.

Phonics

- As your child missed their year 1 phonics screening check in the last academic year, we will be catching up with this in the second half of the Autumn term. We may, therefore, set some extra phonics homework via the seesaw class app during the autumn term, or your child may be given some phonics sounds to work on at home.
