



<p><b><u>Life Cycle of a Chicken</u></b></p> <p>During our topic, the children will learn about the different stages of a chicken's life cycle. They will act out each stage of the life cycle, order pictures and try to describe the changes in each stage.</p> 	<p><b><u>Farm Animals</u></b></p> <p>The children will learn about different farm animals, how the farmer takes care of them and how an adult animal would look after its young. The children will also learn the names for the young.</p>	<p><b><u>Farm Products</u></b></p> <p>The products which are created on a farm are extremely important. The children will discuss how they think these are made at the farm and relate them to when they go to the shops to buy different items.</p> 
<p><b><u>Farm Stories</u></b></p> <p>The children will engage with a variety of farm themed stories whilst also being able to explore other themed stories during choosing time and story time.</p>	<p><b><u>Farm Maths</u></b></p> <p>The children will focus on recognising numbers, counting and finding the missing numbers when in order to 5 and beyond.</p> <p>They will also compare different weights of farm animals and name a variety of 2D and 3D shapes along with their properties.</p>	<p><b><u>Naming Clothes</u></b></p> <p>Please ensure that all your child's belongings are named clearly. We seem to have a significant number of cardigans and jumpers which have no name and it is difficult to know who they belong to.</p>
