### School Meals

Due to increased energy and food costs, the price of a school dinner for KS2 pupils will increase to £2.50 from September 2022. This is in line with the recommended cost from the Local Authority. Pupils in KS1 and EYFS are entitled to free school meals through current Government funding.

We would like to remind parents we are now able to offer a weekly meal deal, meaning that if children order a meal of any kind—hot meal, jacket potato, sandwich option for the full week Monday—Friday, you will receive one of the meals free—effectively a 20% discount on the week.
