- Create a list of key features, including sequential language and past tense verbs.

Tag Rugby with Hull FC

- This half term coaches from Hull FC will be leading our PE sessions on a Wednesday morning. Teaching the children fundamental skills.

Music:

- Listening and appraising music

Children will also explore and compare a range of creation stories from different religions' perspectives.
