

English:

Where possible our literacy work will be linked to our topic of the Romans. We will be covering the following writing genres:

Focusing on:

Music:

This is an integrated approach to music where games, the interrelated dimensions of music (pulse, rhythm, pitch etc.), singing and playing instruments are all linked. IN recorders we will add to the three notes we have already learnt and begin to perform more complex pieces.



Science:

The children will learn the names of some animals and common colours. We will use our new vocabulary to ask and answer questions.

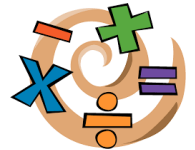


Maths
