

## English:

Where possible our literacy work will be linked to our topic of 'living things'. We will be covering the Daily homework - Reading and Reading challenges. (See home reading book for more information)

### Focusing on:

Cursive handwriting

Paragraphs

Interesting punctuation

Additional writing devices such as adverbial openers, using alliteration and similes.



## Religion and World Views

'Sacred places' is our topic this term. We will be discovering what 'sacred' means and different places of worship.



## PSHE / RSE -

We will be looking at why we need to look after our bodies and the importance of a healthy diet, exercise and keeping clean. Next, we'll focus on 'money matters' and where money comes from and how we can look after it.

## Maths:

We will follow the White Rose Maths scheme focusing on the four operations. We'll also be covering fractions, measures, statistics, shape and time.

The children will be using all these skills to be mathematical detectives and solve reasoning problems.

**Daily homework** - Times Table Rockstars. (10 minutes per day)

We are focusing on the 2,3,4,6 and 8 times tables.



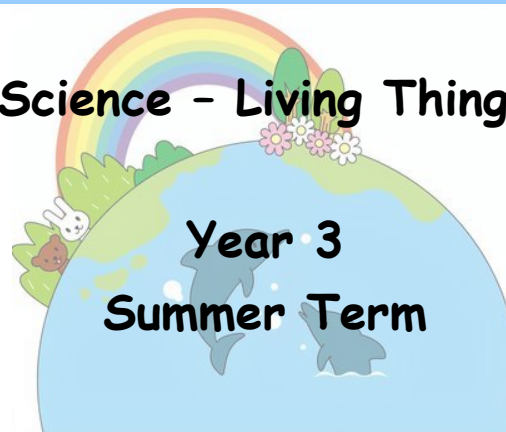
## Music:

### Focusing on:

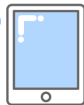
Knowing and applying rules.
