<p><u>Our bodies</u></p> <p>We will be naming the different parts of our body and will learn about the importance of washing our hands thoroughly to stop germs spreading. We will also talk about how we all have different coloured eyes, hair and skin.</p> 	<p><u>Our 5 senses</u></p> <p>We will have lots of opportunities to explore using our 5 senses in fun and practical ways. We will try to guess what different objects are using just one sense for example items in a feely bag or listening to different environmental sounds.</p> 	<p><u>Different occupations</u></p> <p>We will be learning about the different kinds of jobs people do. We will start by asking parents or relatives to talk about their own jobs, with their children. We will also find out about the different jobs people do in school such as the school cooks and cleaners.</p> 
<p><u>Books and stories</u></p> <p>We will be reading From Head To Toe by Eric Carle and Giraffe's Can't Dance by Giles Andreae. We will also be looking at simple information books about the senses. The children will have the opportunity to explore other themed stories during choosing time and story time.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>We will be following our new maths scheme Mastering The Curriculum which starts with early maths concepts of sorting objects to create a set and matching objects.
